Dear Parents/ Carers

Over the forthcoming weeks pupils will be continuing with our Science, Safety, Citizenship and PSHE topics. We will be delivering all lesson through a cross curricular approach and therefore there can be no withdrawal.

The aims of this topic are:

- To introduce children to the physical and emotional changes that occur during puberty.
- To consider some of the changes over which we have no control and the choices we can make concerning the transitions.
- To discuss personal safety and keeping themselves safe.

It is important that this work also challenges attitudes and helps students to develop emotional and social skills. Pupils will learn about different safety subjects such as county line gangs, grooming, child sexual exploitation etc. The work we are going to do is recommended for 7 to 11 year old children so it will be appropriate and easy to understand.

In the past children have enjoyed the lessons and learnt a great deal. Some of the lessons will be taught separately, in girl and boy groups.
