Reminder: Timings of school day


Morning gates open at 8.30am (school starts at 8.45am)

Autumn weather reminder!






In Violet Base we have been learning about World War Two. As part of this exciting topic, we had a special visitor who came into school to help bring our learning to life! It was a very enjoyable time.
