The children that were chosen by their teacher this week to receive the award in our assembly:




Well done to our winners this week in Rainbow, Orange, Yellow and Green Bases!

Wednesday 20th December - Nursery children's Christmas parties and Santa visit!






Friday 22nd December - Last day of Term! Children to be collected at 12pm!
