
# Educational Visits!



This week, the children in our Rainbow Provision had a rather icy Forest School session! They explored the frozen ground, ice puddles and frozen pond before warming up with marshmallows on our campfire.

The children were learning key vocabulary in context by feeling and touching the ice, smashing the frozen pond and warming up on the hot fire. Fabulous physical development trekking up the 'mountains' and navigating the uneven surfaces.

This week, Year 4 have been on an educational visit to Leeds City Museum to learn about the Ancient Greeks. We had a wonderful workshop where the children were able to handle Ancient Greek objects that were over 2500 years old! The children also loved exploring all the different exhibits in the Museum and they really enjoyed sketching different artefacts and writing down interesting facts they came across!
