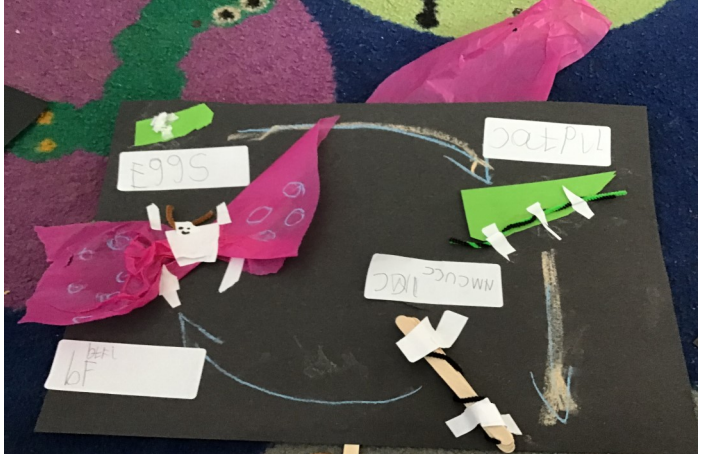
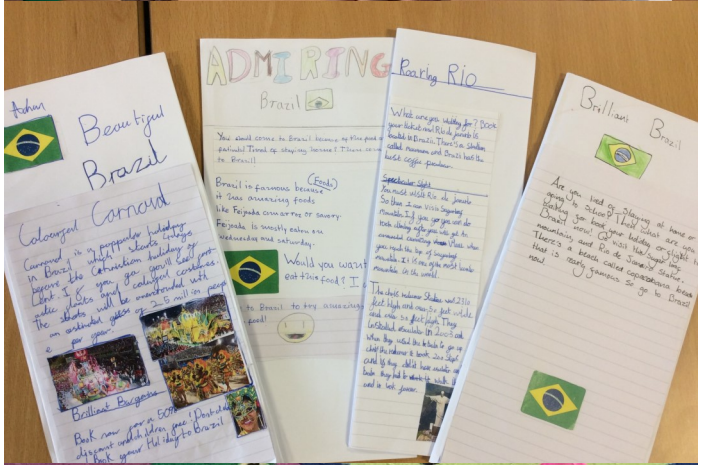
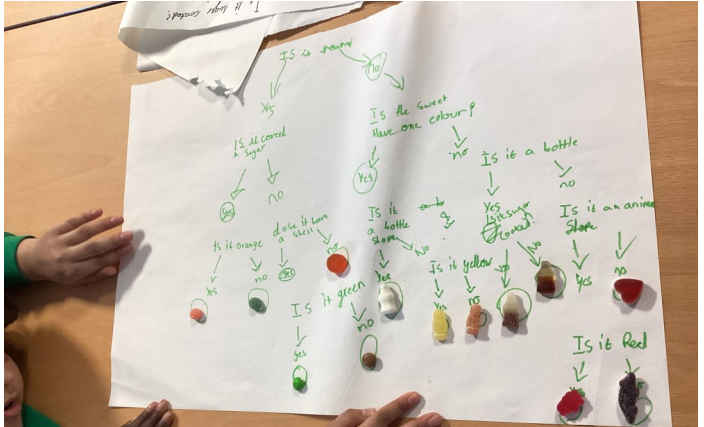


Parent/Carer Upcoming Sessions:
