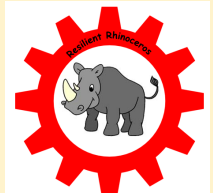
Learning Cog focus—Collaboration!

Football Fever at Bankside!

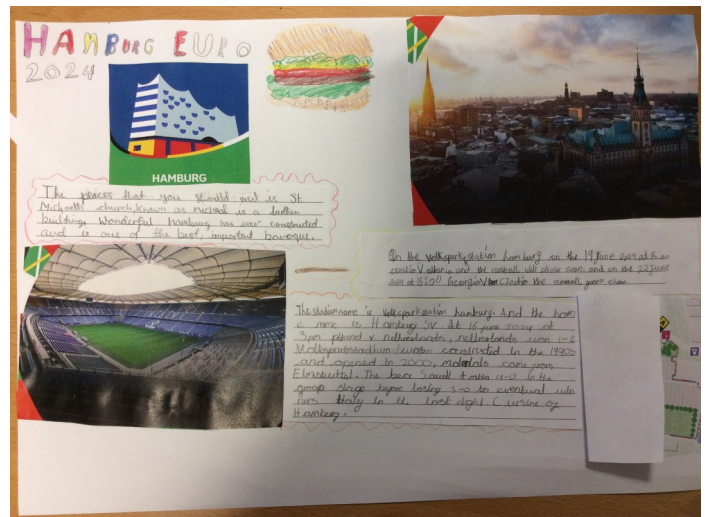
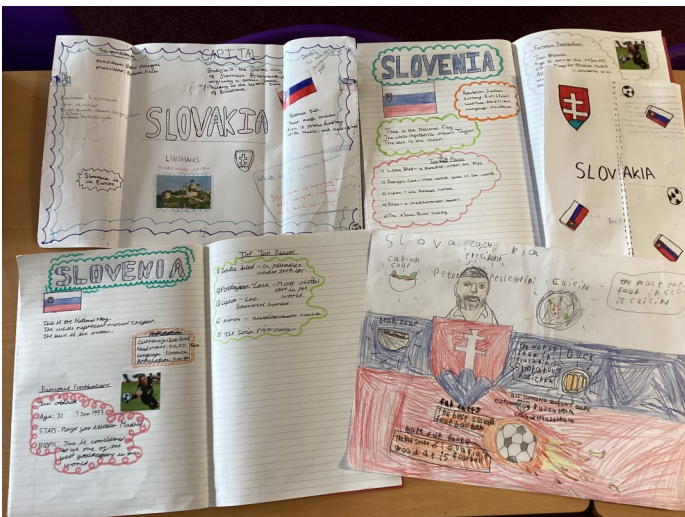
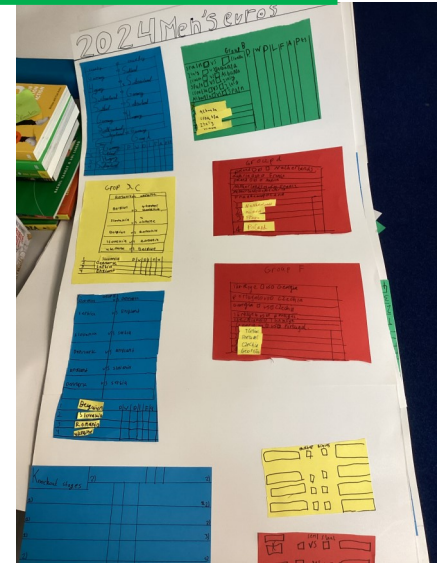


Children are enjoying their football festival sessions that are taking place over the next two weeks to celebrate our learning around National School Sports Week and the Euros 2024!
