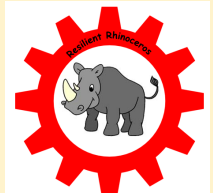
Learning Cog focus—Resilience!

The children that were chosen by their teacher this week to receive the award in our assembly:

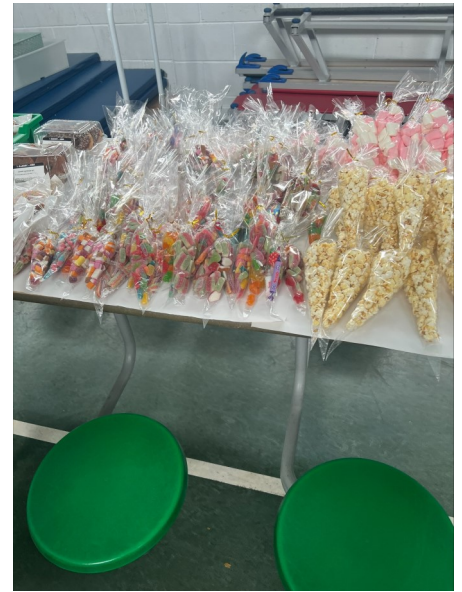


Well done to our winners this week in Blue, Indigo and Violet Bases!

Next week our learning cog will be resilience, stay tuned to see who the winners will be in Orange, Yellow, Green and Rainbow Bases!



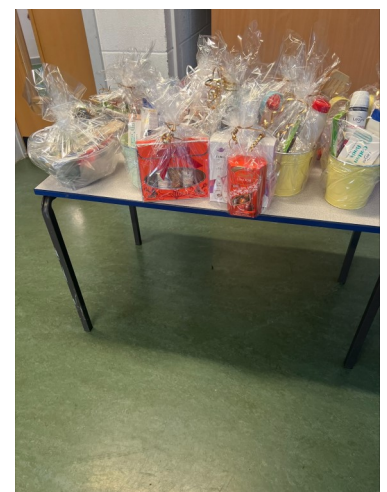
Community Fundraising!



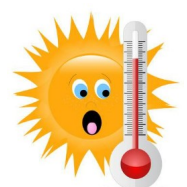
A huge thank you to all of the staff and parents/ carers who helped host our community fundraiser after school on Monday 24th June!

The event had a great turnout and was all about raising money for the amazing projects that are run through our family support team in partnership with the Children's Centre.



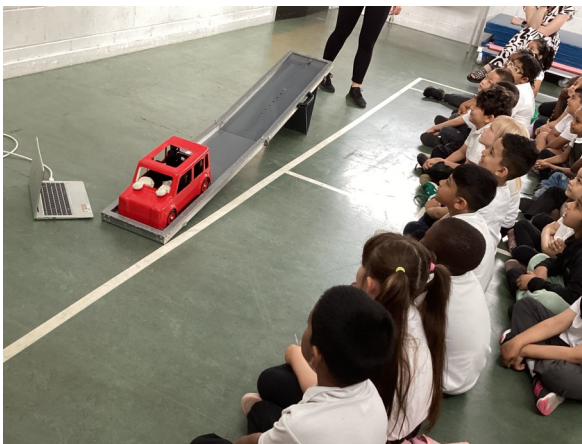
Please ensure that your child has a water bottle with them at all times whilst at school. **A polite reminder that children may only drink water** in their water bottle.
