stay tuned to see who the winners will be!



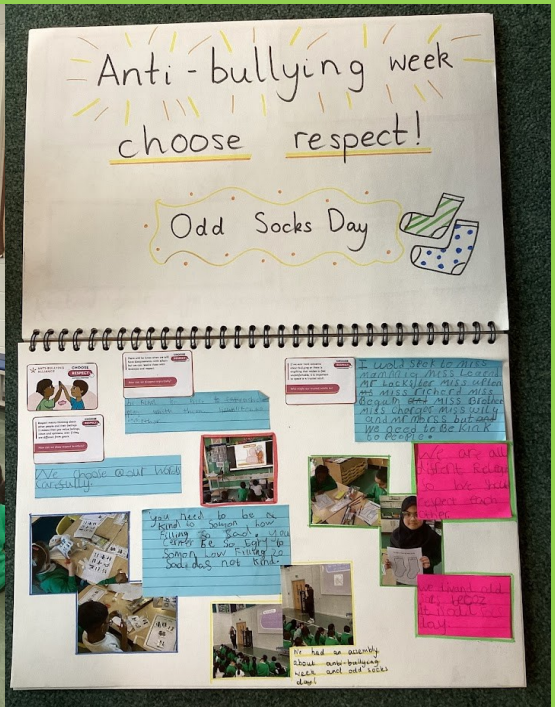
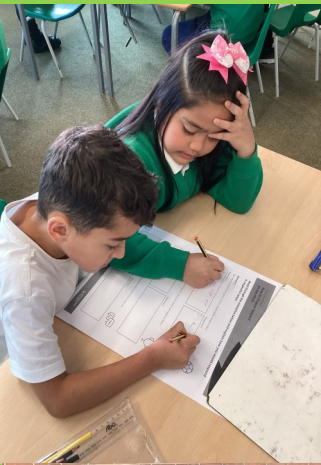
# Anti-Bullying Week!
