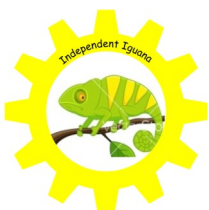

Uniform Reminder!

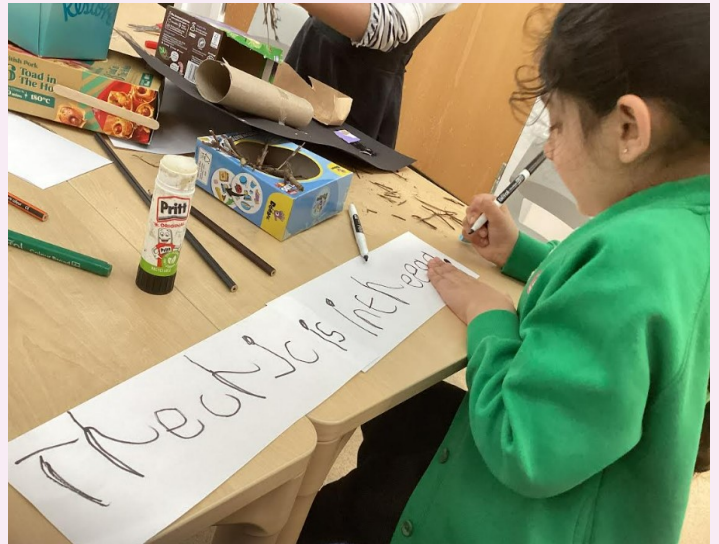
