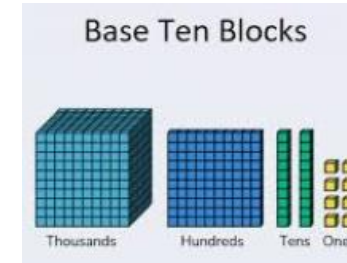
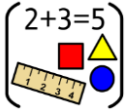
Science:

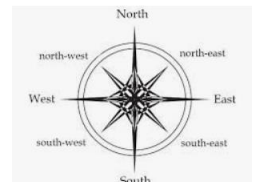
Maths:

Geography:

In geography we are learning about the points of a compass and map-reading. Learning the points of a compass and using co-ordinates to locate areas on maps for future budding explorers!



PSHE:

In computing we are following our programming scheme. Children follow instructions to be creative and modify ready-made learning code and know that prediction and trial and error are important processes in design.



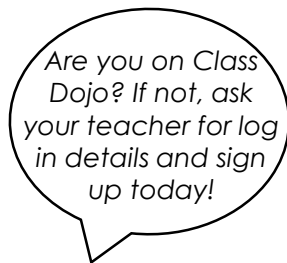
Art
