Well done to the children in Key Stage Two this week who were chosen by their teacher to receive the award in our headteacher's assembly!

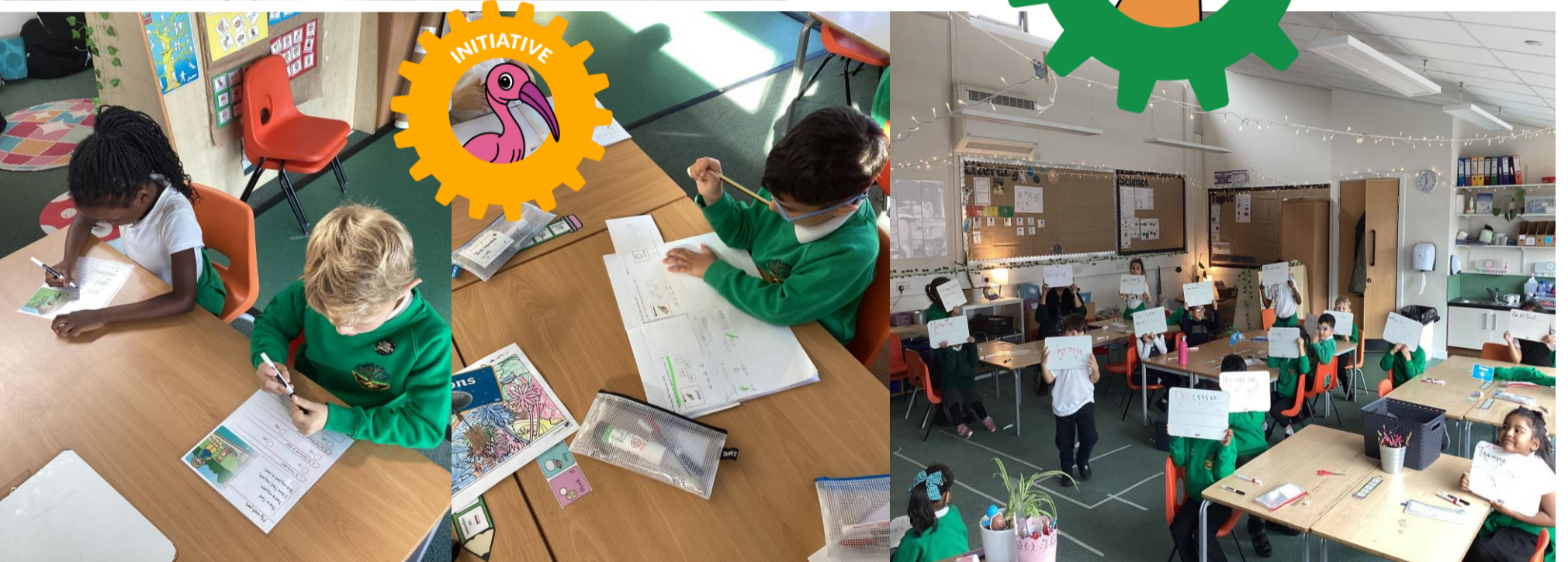
Next week our learning cog will be empathy. Stay tuned to see who the winners are in Key Stage One!
