Well done to the children in Key Stage One this week who were chosen by their teacher to receive the award in our headteacher's assembly!

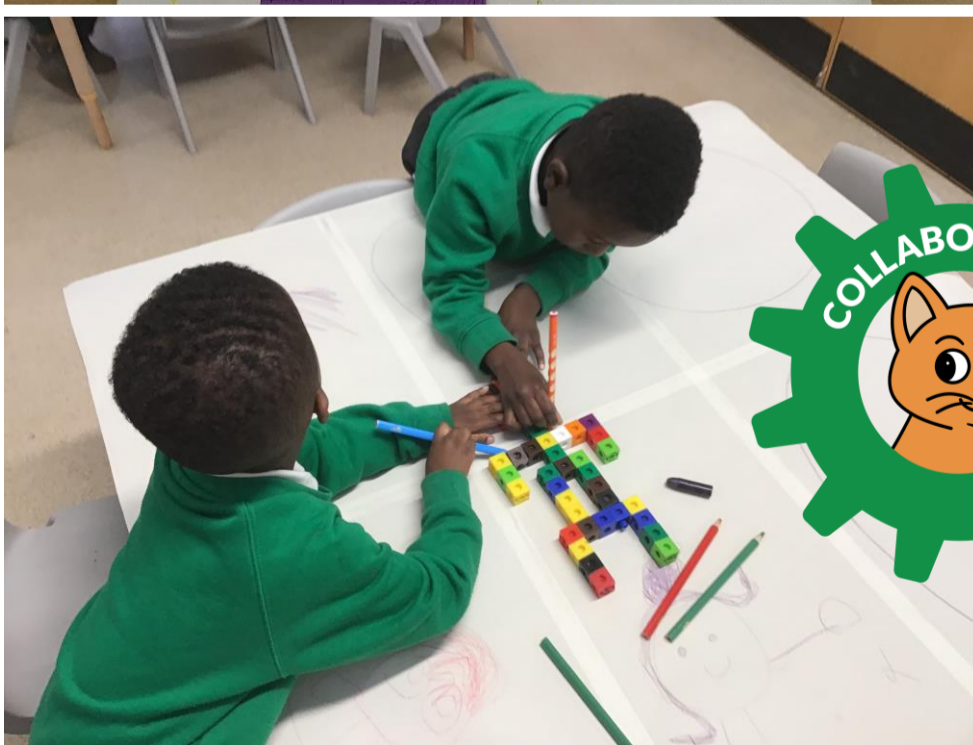
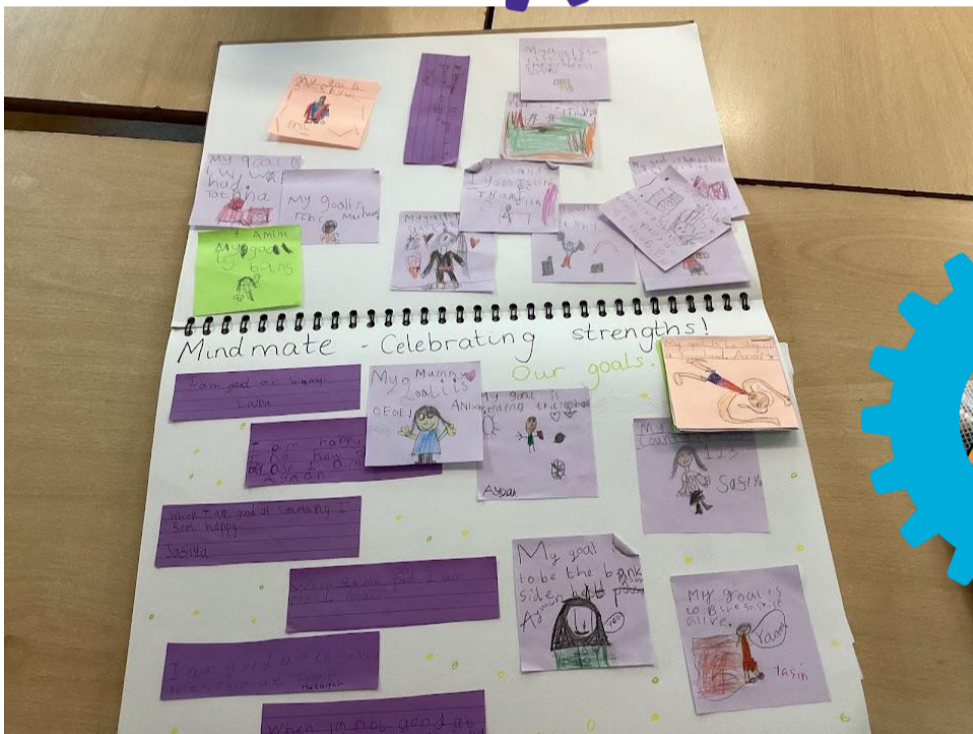
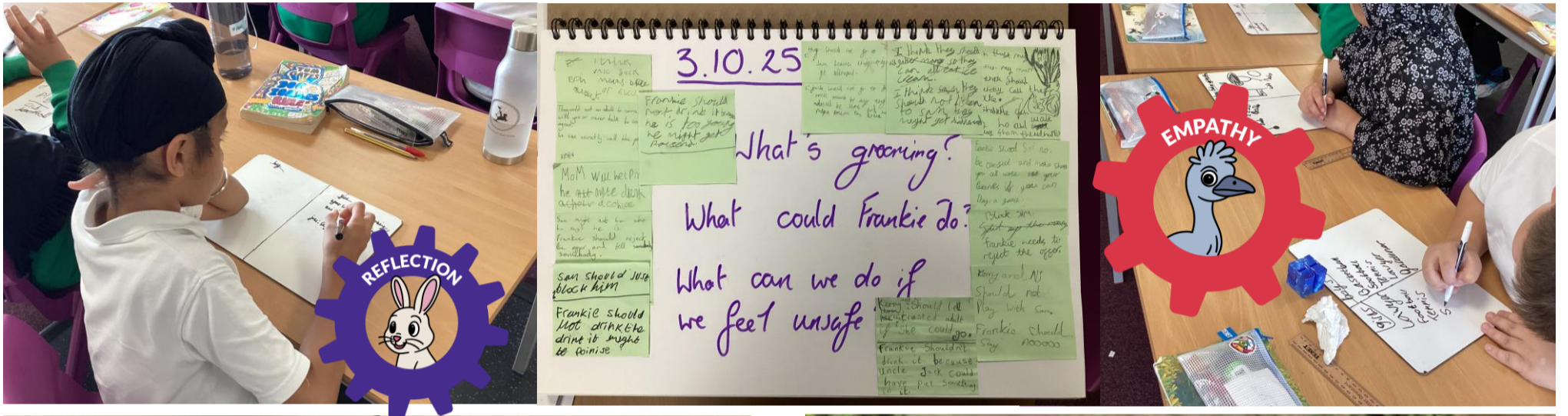
