

Well done to the children this week in Key Stage Two who were chosen by their teacher to receive the award in our headteacher's assembly!




# Curriculum Enrichment!


We are delighted to share that our recent ten-pin event placed a strong focus on personal development, giving children the opportunity to learn and grow new skills in a supportive environment.
