Well done to the children in Years 1, 2 and 3 this week who were chosen by their teacher to receive the award in our headteacher's assembly!

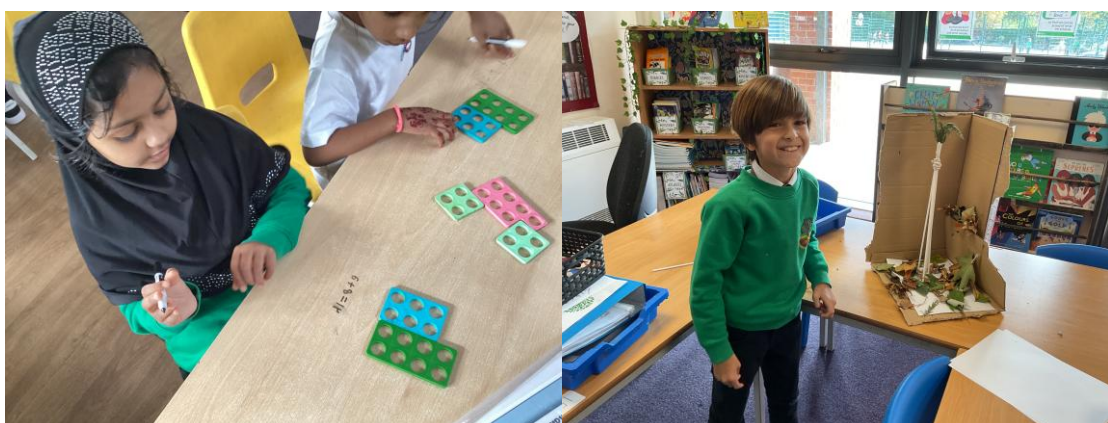
Next week we will see who the winners are in Years 4, 5 and 6!
