### **Behaviour Learning Centre (BLC)**

BLC is also the place where children who have had a dispute at lunchtime or playtime are brought in by staff. In BLC we learn about our behaviour, we discuss ways to make the problem smaller, this might be through giving an I message, writing a letter, having time to think about our behaviour and also thinking of how we are going to own our behaviour so that we do not repeat the same behaviour.

#### 'I' messages

We are taught that at Bankside we share an 'l' message to explain both the problem and to think of a way to make the problem smaller · We say 'I felt ...' (sad, upset, angry etc) 'When you ...' (pushed, kicked, said something unkind) 'I would like you to ...' (say sorry, not do it again, be a kind friend

again) Our Teachers also model this for us
